

# THE CANDY EGG

Take advantage of the multitude of cheap plastic eggs that show up in every store in the spring for this fun word play activity!

## Supplies

- plastic eggs
- sight words
- candy (optional)

## Preparation

Print a word list and cut the words apart so each one is on a small slip of paper. Open the plastic eggs and fill each one with a word. In addition to the word, place a small piece of candy in one of the eggs. Hide the eggs within a room or outside in the yard.

Your youngster's job is to find the eggs and read the word inside with each find. Give him/her the opportunity to read the words on his/her own. The game is over when your child finds the egg with the candy. (I tend to hide the candy egg real well!)

You won't have to ask if your child wants to play this again. Your child will *beg* you to play it again! How fortunate that your little learner is also practicing sight words!
