

What supplies do I need for Reading House activities?

You'll need **little more** than books and everyday objects from around the house for most Reading House games and activities! The lessons are designed to be natural explorations of literature in the sense that they can be done during family time, without extensive preparation. You needn't buy expensive audiotapes/CDs, specific book titles, or boxed games. Any book appropriate for your child's age will do! For many of the activities **all you'll need** is a book!

If it's important to you to stock up on the most commonly used items for Reading House activities, a short list of supplies is given below. You probably have most of these items at home already. Remember, only the most frequently used supplies are listed here. Other activities may require a few extras.
